PROJECTS & PRESENTATIONS

Floyd, C. 3-Part Data Review Focused on UHC's Counseling and Psychiatric Service "Access" Model Program Improvement and Analysis abstract accepted on November 3, 2025, for presentation at American Public Health Association Conference.

- Evaluated the effectiveness and accessibility of a university mental health service model using student and clinician feedback; data showed the model was effective in initial visits, but highlighted a need for increased on-campus clinician staffing, shorter wait times, and more varied appointment availability to address the student perception of barriers and reliance on community referrals.

Floyd, C. Stakeholder Engagement and Retention in HIV Care: A PIHC Pilot Study.

- Analyzed stakeholder partnership data in HIV care, finding that while overall experience strongly correlated with satisfaction, perceived value and communication quality did not reliably predict retention, highlighting the need for refined engagement strategies beyond just making stakeholders feel valued.
